Papers (Full- 10-15 pages ; Short - 8 pages, in the proceedings) as well as abstracts (400-500 words) must be in English and may be submitted at

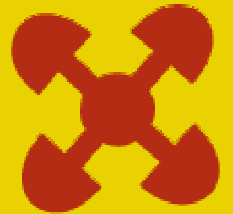
